- (F₁) Under CSSTE we have very less number of staff members. We have less than 25% staff members. We are getting only 25% of budget for programs and other activities. They are giving us 25% of budget this by the time it comes from state government. Majority of the budget goes into salary of the staffs and other things.
- (F₂) We are organizing our training programs and workshops by organizing funds from SSA and RMSA.
- (F₁) We have all the information about CSSTE in our Annual work plan which includes information from all the DIETs and CTEs, IASE.
- (F₂) This year for the first time in past few years ^{not} we have been receiving any fund last few years. We are receiving any funding from CSSTE. This fund is yet to be transferred to us.
- (F₁) None of Faculty have support for all the work load.
- (F₂) We don't get funds and our funds are lapses every year. We
- (F₁) When there is no fund and faculty we can't work on our own.
