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

Subject: Forwarding of minutes of the TEAB Meeting held on 29th December, 2012 for considering proposals received from State Government under Teacher Education Scheme.

Please find enclosed copy of minutes of the 5th meeting of Teacher Education Approval Board (TEAB) under the Chairpersonship of Secretary (SE&L). Which was held on 29th December, 2012, at 10:30 A.M. in the Conference Room (Room No. 112 C Wing), Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi to discuss the proposals received from the States of West Bengal, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Punjab, and Part Proposal of Tamil Nadu (CTEs and IASEs) and Mizoram (non-recurring) for implementation of TE scheme for the financial year 2012-13 for action.



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4. The proposals received from the State Governments were taken up State-wise.

5. **West Bengal:**

5.1. Shri Arnab Roy, Secretary (School Education), State Govt. of West Bengal, made a presentation, highlights of which are as under:

- Due to high population density in several districts, the State was at a disadvantage. He requested that financial assistance should be considered on either population-wise or block wise norms.
- In West Bengal, in addition to Revenue Districts, there are some Educational Districts also. The Centrally Sponsored Schemes are being considered only on the basis of Revenue Districts only. There should be financial assistance for Educational Districts also.
- The State has taken up recruitment drive to fill up the vacancies of teacher educators.
- Out of 14 Universities, 11 Universities have Department of Education. The remaining 3 Universities have been established very recently and eventually Department of Education would also be established in these universities.
- State requires more Institutes to be set up particularly for preparation of primary teachers.
- Initiative has been taken to train the teachers on ODL mode.
- SCERT is proposed to be revamped. At present there are 25 posts of Academic and 56 posts of non-academic staff.
- Out of requirement of 14 BITEs, 11 BITEs are proposed to be established by up-gradation of existing teacher training institutes.
- Approval was sought for up-gradation of PTTI at Darjeeling into DIET and PTTI at Saikia into BITE during the current financial year and financial assistance of Rs.3 crore was sought @ Rs.1.5 crore per institute.

5.2. After the presentation, following observations were made by Members of TEAB:

- Training of teachers on ODL mode can only be a stop gap arrangement and it cannot be made permanent. Training on distance mode should be used only as a temporary measure for the in-service teachers and States should take steps to establish institutions for training of teachers on face-to-face mode.
- State was advised to look into the model of requirement of staff for SCERT given in the guidelines of TE scheme, while proposing restructuring SCERT.
- It was also observed that the absence of academic staff in SCERT has led to the non-revision of curriculum

5.3. After discussions, the TEAB gave in-principle approval for up-gradation of Government/sponsored PTTIs at Mahmmad Bazar (Distt. Birbhum), Katwa (Distt. Bardhaman), Nigamananda Shikshaniketan (Distt. Coochbehar), Dharmada (Distt. Nadia), Shiksha Sangha (Distt. South 24 Parganas), Ramganj (Distt. Distt. Uttar Dinajpur), Sabrakone (Distt. Bankura), Bibhuti Bhushan (Distt. North 24 Parganas), Salkai (Distt.

- In principle approval was sought for strengthening of physical infrastructure in existing 27 DIETs, even though the State has provided the PWD estimates only for 3 DIETs.
- Budgetary provision will be made based on the approval given by the Centre.

6.2 After the presentation, following observations were made by Members of TEAB:

- Member Secretary, NCTE desired to have a copy of curriculum being used for refresher training course of secondary and higher secondary teachers.
- Financial assistance cannot be provided for Educational Districts.
- Financial assistance for replacement of old equipments for EDUSAT would be considered next year, depending on the funds earmarked for TE scheme.
- State Govt. should indicate, in writing, the actual amount that is earmarked in the budget, Secretary, SE&L directed the Education Secretary to immediately submit in writing about the funds earmarked, which will be taken on record, for release of funds.

6.3 After discussion, The TEAB approved up-gradation of existing Government D.Ed institutions in the 3 newly created districts of Chikbalapur, Ramnagar and Yadagir as DIETs, up-gradation of Government College of Education, Chikbalapur and Government aided KLE College of Education as CTEs,, and up-gradation of Department of Education, Gulbarga University as an IASE. The TEAB also approved civil works of Rs 93.75 lakh for academic infrastructure for DIET, Bangalaoe (south), Rs 93.00 lakh for civil works (Residence and teacher training Rs 79.50 lakh, sanitation block Rs 13.50 lakh) for DIET, Davangere, Rs 68.25 lakh for civil works of DIET, Dharwad (Rs 38.25 for laboratories, Rs 15.00 lakh for Lecture Room and Rs 15.00 lakh for training hall), equipment garnt of Rs 540 lakh for 27 DIETs (@Rs 20 lakh per DIET), equipment grant of Rs 200.00 lakh @ Rs 20 per CTE for the 10 CTEs, equipment grant of Rs 20.00 lakh for the existing IASE, Rs 44.00 lakh for establishment of Special Cells for ET, Languages, Science, Social Science and Mathematics for SCERT, and equipment grant of Rs 30.00 lakh for the SCERT. The TEAB approved financial assistance of Rs.5622.00 lakhs for implementation of the TE scheme in the State of Karnataka, details of which is as follows:

8. Mizoram

8.1. As TEAB had already considered the proposal of the State Govt. and the present proposal was only in respect of the non-recurring components under the Scheme, Ms. Malswaithangi, Director, SCERT, Govt. of Mizoram, made a presentation on behalf of Secretary (Education), Govt. of Mizoram. The State Government requested that claim of financial assistance for civil works of SCERT may be considered as detailed estimates as per the SOR of the State PWD have been submitted. The TEAB recommended the following non-recurring components:

- (i) Up-gradation of the 6 DRCs as DIETs and Rs 1485.78 lakh for construction of institute building for the 6 DRCs, and equipment grant of Rs 60.00 lakh for the 6 DRCs;
- (ii) Rs 414.80 lakh for construction of hostel building and equipment grant of Rs 40.00 lakh in respect of the 2 DIETs;
- (iii) Rs 175.68 lakh for civil works, Rs 9.91 lakh for ET lab, Rs 8.75 lakh for Social Science lab, Rs 9.93 lakh for Science lab, Rs 3.13 lakh for Mathematics lab for SCERT;
- (iv) Rs 25.00 lakh for civil works for vertical extension of the IASE building, out of total estimates of Rs 125.00 lakh.

8.2 After discussion, financial assistance of Rs.2262.99 lakhs was approved for implementation of the TE scheme in the State of Mizoram, details of which are as follows:


