15. Shri Nand Kumar, Secretary, Department of School Education, Chattisgarh made an introductory statement, which was followed by a Power Point Presentation. The main highlights of the presentation are summarized as under:

- (i) The literacy rate is 64.66% (Male- 77.38%; Female- 51.85%).
- (ii) There are 18 revenue districts, with 146 blocks, 2069 clusters and 19744 villages. Out of 53051 schools, 34420 are primary, 14113 elementary, 2104 secondary and 2414 senior secondary schools.
- (iii) At primary level, there are 75722 teachers, of which 23337 teachers are untrained (30.82%).
- (vi) At elementary level, there are 35848 teachers, of which 12281 teachers are untrained (34.26%).
- (v) At secondary level, there are 10921 teachers, of which 3704 teachers are untrained (33.92%).
- (vi) At senior secondary level, there are 20883 teachers, of which 5081 teachers are untrained (24.34%).
- (vii) Out of the 761 sanctioned posts in DIETs, 397 are filled and 364 are vacant.
- (viii) Numbers of students, teacher educators etc in Government institutes are indicated below:

16. TEAB noted that 48% are vacant in DIETs. Secretary (SE&L) observed that major vacancies are in academic category in DIETs. She was of the view that academic position should not remain vacant as the DIETs cannot fulfil their task without faculty support. Secretary, Department of School Education, Chhattisgarh assured that academic positions will be filled up within two months after the expiry of model code of conduct.

17. State Government is not claiming salary grant for CTEs/IASEs. This is due to the fact that the State Government has not filled up adequate number of posts. TEAB urged State Government to fill up academic and non academic posts in CTEs/IASEs, so that the institutions could function properly, as envisaged under the Scheme.

18. TEAB approved Rs. 64.16 lakh for the projects of SCERT indicated in the State plan except the project on 'support to EDUSAT, making it more resourceful and accessible', subject to the condition that Rs. 32.08 lakh is released by the State Government as matching share for the projects.

19. The requirement for salary for the financial year 2009-10 has been calculated on the basis of midpoint of the pay scale multiplied by 2.5. However, it is possible that the actual expenditure may vary from the calculated amount. The State Government may communicate the variation, if any which can then considered for additional Central assistance.

20. With a view to releasing the Central assistance to States/UTs in time, State Governments should communicate the expenditure position for the year 2008-09 as well as unspent balance position as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2009 to MHRD by 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2009. Accordingly, first instalment (1/3<sup>rd</sup>) of the recurring Central assistance approved by TEAB for the year 2009-10 will be released. 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the recurring Central assistance for the year 2009-10 will be released as second instalment in August, 2009.

21. State Government should fill-up the vacant academic and non-academic posts during the financial year 2009-10. Consequently, the financial requirement on account of additional filled-up posts along with full details should be communicated to MHRD for releasing the additional Central assistance to the State.

22. Unspent balance as on 31.3.2009 will be treated as resource for the year 2009-10. State Government is allowed to utilize the unspent balance for the purpose for which the Central assistance was released.

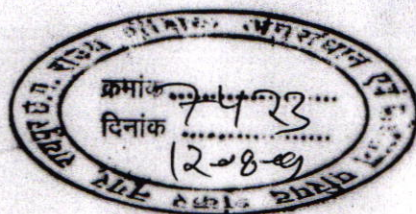

Utilisation report of amount being released by this sanction letter shall be forwarded by the State Govt. at the earliest, and in any case within three months from close of the financial year.
- (vii) Accounts of all grantee institutions shall be made available for inspection by the sanctioning authority for audit whenever asked to do so.
